Okay folks, Christmas is just around the corner. That means the Corvette Club of South Australia's world famous Christmas Dinner is also just around the corner.



Monday morning came, and we had to join the queue of Yorke Peninsula holiday traffic back to Adelaide. All I can say is "Curse those caravan drivers".


Good ol' Pt Wakefield was chaos as usual but we detoured to the Rising Sun Hotel in the back streets for one last meal together.

# **Membership Renewal Information**



Dear Member,

I hope that this letter finds you and your family fit and well. It is that time of year when our fees are due for renewal and it would be greatly appreciated if you could find the time to pay your fees online. This will make things a lot easier at our meetings in November and December.

# Important information for those on the Conditional Registration Scheme.

Membership of a Club must be paid and Log books must be signed before 31st December 2025 for vehicles to be able to continue to be legally driven on the road. If your log book isn't signed by this date then you will be driving an unregistered vehicle. This will also mean that if you are involved in an accident that your car will be uninsured for third party bodily injury insurance. None of us want to see that costly event happen to anyone.

Issuing of new log books are required every 3 years.

If your log book is not signed, please notify the club registrar with the reason why (e.g. car off road for repairs or other reasons) before the 31st December 2025.

If your membership has not been renewed and the log book signed before the 31st December 2025, the Club is required to notify the DPTI of your Non-Financial Status. We will be notifying DPTI as of the 31<sup>st</sup> of January 2026 as to any members that have not renewed. DPTI may then **cancel Conditional Registration** for your vehicle within 7 days and **your car will not be covered. Fines and or more can apply along with your loss of conditional registration.** 

It is a requirement under the new code that the club notifies the department as a condition of maintaining our recognition status for the purposes of the scheme.

Your support in the form of membership and participation in the club is vital in ensuring our ongoing success as a club. Our club exists for its members and there are a number of benefits or activities available that members can enjoy. They include the following;

- · A full colour newsletter each month by email.
- Monthly General meeting.
- Club car runs on the first Sunday after each monthly general meeting (organised by any member that wishes to arrange a run. Feel free to ask for advice).
- Club dinners every third Friday of the month (arranged by club members and held at various locations around Adelaide).
- Access to Technical knowledge and expertise (some members have over 35 years' experience).
- Access to exclusive Club Merchandise.
- Lucky members draw for those present at the Monthly meeting.
- Organised regular events such as Club car runs both locally and interstate.
- Hosting of the Corvette Nationals when it occurs in Adelaide (generally every six years).
- A dedicated committee of volunteers.

Full Membership fees are only \$80 per year for Metro members and \$40 for Country members. Associate membership fees are only \$20. Log Books are \$10 so please check that yours is in date before paying your fees and include that in your payment. Payment can be made to BSB: 105-900 ACCOUNT: 9543 73840 and please ensure that your surname and membership number are included. 

To travel as a group, particularly on a long trip as this, does not only give support to each other but is a great social event to share stories along the way.

The overnight stops will be - Hay 655kms, 7hrs. Coonabarabran 676kms, 7hrs. Warick to Noosa 298kms, 4hrs.

These distances take into consideration comfortable travelling times as well as for the older Corvettes which do not have the same creature comfort as those younger.

Once I have your expressions of interest's I will make the appropriate motel bookings for the type of accommodation required and you pay the establishment on check out.

As a guide an overnight stop is approximately \$180 but this will vary dependent on the establishment and how many rooms are booked.

In reviewing the accommodation prices at the Nationals I have booked seven rooms at the Noosa Heads Motel which is 1.5kms away from where the Nationals are being held.

Currently I have one room available at \$242 per night over the period of the Nationals so get in quickly if interested as any future room bookings at this establishment will be much more expensive.


